WE ARE GETTING CLOSER!

Last April the XXX ISSCT CONGRESS was launched at a national level in a formal Ceremony at the San Martin Palace, venue of the National Ministry of Foreign Affairs, before Ambassadors and Counselors of about 30 countries, and office bearers of national public and private institutions.



The facilities of the Sociedad Rural de Tucumán are a former sugar mill and will be the venue of the XXX ISSCT Congress. The Organising Committee together with the hosting association are currently finishing the renovation works at its facilities. Thus, Tucuman will have for the first time in history, a Convention Center for over 1,500 people.

Over 300 papers and posters were received and accepted. We are certain that you will find many of them of great interest.

The COC is also proud to announce that the National Government has recently declared the XXX ISSCT Congress “An event of National Interest” based on the relevance of its content, the economic impact in the region and the importance of the sugar and energy industry. There have been 7 similar declarations at municipal and provincial level as well.

Given that we are doing our best to offer you a great Congress, we wish to inform delegates that **registration for the PRE CONGRESS and POST CONGRESS tours and visits ends on 15 AUGUST, 2019**. MON 02 SEP – COOKING CLASS AND CITY TOUR

The popular “*empanadas*” from Tucumán are famous in Argentina for being the best in the country. Dough, meat filling, twisted edges and oven are not a secret anymore when the knowledge and the experience is transmitted with passion by our cooking friends. With a slice of lemon slice and a glass of red wine, this is the best starter for any meal. Also, other meals are part of the local cuisine: *humita*, *tamales* and a long list of typical dishes. We will try some of them during our lunch.

Historical city - Tucumán

Come to this tour and see the roots of the history of modern Argentina. We will help you understand the decisive moment in the country's history*Plaza Independencia and its surroundings: House of Government, San Francisco Temple, the Cathedral, La Merced Church and the Historical House*.

We will visit Parque 9 de Julio and the Obispo Colombres Museum of Sugar Cane Industry. In the surroundings of Plaza Urquiza: the Legislature, the Casino, San Martin Theatre and the National School. Also, the Casa Belgraniana.

(*)The historical Center tour is on foot (one hour approx.)

Start 11.30 am. Finish: 5.30 pm.

TUESDAY 03 SEP

SAN JAVIER, VILLA NOUGUÉS, EL CADILLAL, RACO Y EL SIAMBÓN.

We will drive through Yerba Buena on the way to La Rinconada to start our way driving up through the exuberant Yungas Rainforest until we reach the exclusive Villa Nougues, built during the 19th century amidst hills and ravines. A few kilometers ahead, we will find Loma Bola, where hang gliders and paragliders lift off. San Javier offers an exceptional view of the city from the Cristo Redentor. This summer villa is a natural area protected by Universidad Nacional de Tucumán and it is a natural refuge and a reservoir of clear water.

For lunch we have a reservation with the best view of Tucumán: a glassed restaurant in Hotel San Javier with different views to the city.

Then, Raco and El Siambón await us with its Monastery of Benedictine Monks. Finishing this beautiful tour, we will visit a dam known as El Cadillal before driving back to the city.

Start 08:30 am – Finish: 4.30 pm

WEDNESDAY 04 SEP

YUNGAS, LOS MENHIRES, TAFÍ Y AMAICHA DEL VALLE, CIUDAD SAGRADA DE QUILMES and BODEGA.

This tour combines the magnificent views with the best wines from Tucumán. Route 307 leads you up to the valleys running along with Los Sosa River ravine in the Yungas. Finally, Tafí del Valle offers unique landscapes.

Stop at the Villa. Then we will continue in a deep zigzag until the Infiernillo at 3.042 m (above sea level). The Valle Calchaquí splits in front of you as your cameras try to catch the jaw-dropping view. In Amaicha del Valle: we visit the main square and its surroundings. After joining route 40, the sacred aboriginal city of Quilmes emerges on the left. On the foot of the mountain there appear the remains of a military area and on top, there is a fortress and two forts on the sides. We will take a walk around the last site where aboriginals lived before the Spanish conquest.

We will also visit a wine cellar in Tucumán: the wine in the Valley softly passes through your mouth and soul as a way of blessing from the Pachamama –*mother nature*-producing quality nectars from ancient times.

Start 08:00 am – Finish 6:30 pm

THURSDAY 05 SEP

We will visit the Miguel Lillo Museum of Natural Sciences of Universidad Nacional de Tucumán (UNT). Together with Biologists and Nature specialists, we will discover secrets of the immense diversity around Tucumán. In Yerba Buena we will visit Horco Molle to step into the UNT Natural Reserve. The *tapir* or *anta* is the biggest ground mammal in Argentina.

Universidad Nacional de Tucumán has a reserve of *tapirs* and it is part of a captive breeding program and of the *tapir* conservation project in Argentina. This protected area covers 200 hectares and part of the training of future biologists are carried out here: Fauna management, conservation and biodiversity. Short walking, by the Yungas pathways.

On the way back, in Park 9 July we will take a picture of the group and we will finish the day with pure Argentine tradition.

VISA PROCEDURE MADE EASIER

The ISSCT and the ISSCT XXX Congress Organising Committee (COC) would like to convey to all delegates that due to a formal request made by the Argentinian Ministry of Foreign Affairs, EVERY PERSON requesting a visa to enter Argentina MUST - WITHOUT ANY EXCEPTION WHATSOEVER-send an e-mail to secretary@issct-argentina2019.com providing the following details:

- Names/s (as appear in Passport)
- Place/Country of passport issue
- Passport Number
- Nationality
- Personal email

A confirmation mail will be sent back upon receipt of the above information.

These delegates will be included in a list to be presented to Ministry of Foreign Affairs and then sent to all Argentinian Consulates and Embassies to assure an easier process.

Also, this list will be sent to Migrations Office in order to avoid delays at the airport when entering Argentina. The first lists were sent on 1 and 15 July. The rest will be sent on 31 July; 14 and 28 August.

You are requested to kindly abide by the above arrangements which will allow your visa application to be smoothly processed.
